Admissions Requirements

Admission to The Graduate Institute's Master of Arts programs requires candidates to hold a Bachelor's degree with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher. The degree must have provided general academic preparation for graduate study, and must have been awarded by an institution of higher education that is accredited by an agency recognized by the US Secretary of Education.

The Institute may also recognize degrees from foreign institutions of substantial quality and reputation. Applicants whose native language is not English must attain a score of at least 550 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language or demonstrate English proficiency in the essay and interview components of the application.

Auditing a Degree Program

Individuals without Bachelor's degrees may audit a program with special permission from the Provost and the Program Coordinator. Auditors are required to submit all application materials and are expected to complete the program as if they were degree candidates.

Completion of the Admissions File

The following materials must be sent directly to The Graduate Institute's Administrative Offices:

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- Completed Application Form: *two-page hard copy or online form (both available at www.LEARN.edu)*
- Application Fee: *\$60 processing fee payable to The Graduate Institute (nonrefundable)*
- Current Resume: *description of professional credentials and experience*
- Two Letters of Recommendation: *testaments to academic or professional abilities and achievements*
- Official Transcripts from Previously Attended Colleges and Universities: *transcripts sent directly to The Institute in an envelope signed and sealed by the registrar of the degree-granting institution*
- Statement of Intent and Vision: *two-page essay expressing goals for personal and professional development*
- Proof of Immunization: *proof of Measles vaccinations (one administered on or after January 1, 1969 and one administered on or after January 1, 1980) and Rubella vaccinations required by law from all applicants born after December 31, 1956.*
- Interview: *in-person or telephone interview with the Program Coordinator*

Application Deadlines

Applicants are responsible for the submission of all materials, and they are notified with a decision regarding admission once all materials have been submitted and the application file is complete. Applications and supporting materials need not be submitted together. It is recommended that the application form or online application is submitted early, as supporting materials, such as transcripts and letters of recommendation, may take several weeks to arrive. The deadline for receipt of applications and supporting materials is one month before the program's published start date. However, late applications are considered if there is available space in the program. After one year, incomplete applications are removed from active status.
